Not sure how many to order in each size?

Here is a very simple starter ratio you could use, based on an "average" or unknown customer base:

Small: 1 Medium: 3 Large: 6 XL: 5 2X: 2 3X: 1

Keep in mind, if your customer base is a younger crowd, you may want to add more smaller sizes. We all put on a few pounds as we age, (bummer, I know) so if your customer base is an older crowd, you may want to add more of the larger sizes.

An average order of 50 shirts typically looks like this:

Small: 4 Medium: 10 Large: 16 XL: 14 2X: 4 3X: 2

How do your sizes run? Are they true-to-size?

Unisex T-shirts: Run true to size.

Women's V-necks: Semi-Fitted. Run just a bit on the small side. A little tighter through the body. If you prefer a more relaxed fit, I suggest going up a size.

Women's Tanks: Run true to size with a nice flowy body so they're never too tight.

Women's Raglans: Run true to size. A nice generous, regular t-shirt type fit, not the "juniors" fit that you'll find in some places.

Women's Off-shoulder Sweatshirts: Run just a bit on the small side. If you like longer sleeves and a less tight fit, I suggest going up a size.
